## INTRODUCTION

The Accounts set out in the following pages are those kept by the constables of the village of Great Longstone in Derbyshire, between the years 1791 and 1839. The name of the village can, however, be regarded as to some extent immaterial and the Accounts can be considered as typical of any village of this region during the period. It is hoped that they will, with their accompanying notes, be of interest and help to anyone studying similar records of their own locality.

For many of the years the Accounts have been copied in full, but with the remainder the often repeated "To my expences" and payments for attending meetings, receiving orders, and being sworn in, have, in most cases, been omitted. Care has been taken, however, not to omit anything which might be of value, the spelling is as in the original, and any doubtful letters or words have been underlined.

Of special interest are the entries which show how quarterly payments were made for a trained soldier, then for High Constable's warrants, and eventually for the county rate. There is information, too, about the militia and the providing of substitutes, repairs to the village cross and pinfold, and many payments of relief, including that given to eight Americans in 1809.

All the relief payments appearing in the Accounts have been copied as these, when compared with those of other places, will give some idea of the number and of the movements of destitute people with passes, and the number of children on the road.

At some future date it is hoped to deal in the same way with some early churchwarden and overseer accounts and other records.

The history of Longstone has been recorded in "Longstone Records" by G.T.Wright. This work contains a considerable amount of information concerning the church and village. Some additional information was published by the Editor of these Accounts under the title "Further Longstone Records".

Copying and checking old documents takes considerable time, particularly if they are in poor condition, but in doing this work a record will be preserved, and, it is hoped, a worth while contribution will be made to further the aims of the Local History Section of the Derbyshire Archaeological and Natural History Society.

- Ashford Court - Quarter Sessions.
- Swore in Constable - sworn in as constable.
- Last order of Sessions - an order concerning the militia?
- a trained Solder - probably refers to a militia-man, colloquially known as a "trainer".
- Warrant - justices' warrants were directed to High Constables requiring them to issue precepts to petty constables to make inquiry and presentment.
- Presentment - an information laid by a petty constable and presented on oath at Quarter Sessions by the High Constable.
- Vagrant Warrant - justices' warrant ordering a search for vagrants.
- High Constable Meeting - meeting with the High Constable to make a return of presentments.
- Warrant for Watch and Ward - justices' warrant ordering night watch to be kept.
- Presentment for the Highways - a presentment for default in upkeep.
- Land tax - constables were bound to assist collectors of land tax.
- Militia Warrant - justices' warrant requiring the provision of carriages and drivers for passing militia.
- Freehold list - list of names and addresses of freeholders qualified for jury service.
- Surveor of Highways - parish surveyor responsible for highways.
- with a pass - authorising movement of a vagrant from parish to parish.



- Searching Vagrants - searching the parish for vagrants.  
 Hammer and Scratt - tools used on the highways.  
 Wiskets - baskets, no doubt for use on the highways.  
 Militia Lists - lists of men between 18 and 45 years liable  
 for militia service.  
 Meeting for Delivering the freehold - meeting with the High Constable  
 to deliver the freehold list.
